## Honduras Mission Trip

**\*\*Approximate** cost of mission trip: \$600.00 + cost of airline ticket/per participant- Cost of trip and trip agenda are pending the number of participants and the work fund balance (as determined by fundraisers and donations).

- \$600.00 includes-lodging, travel, mission travel insurance and 2 meals (breakfast & dinner) a day while in Honduras (pending trip agenda)
  - Lodging is determined by trip agenda. In the city, it is dorm-style with bunk beds. In the country, it is in a tent or inside a small hut-style home. There is NO air conditioning.
  - Bathrooms are community-style or shared with 5-6 people in same room
- Airline ticket-\*Individuals are responsible for purchasing airline ticket and securing a **valid passport**. Honduras requires your passport be valid for at least six months after entry.
  - We fly Delta because it is a direct flight to Tegucigalpa. Only one flight each day.
  - Delta Flight #849 leaving from Atlanta International Airport (ATL)
  - Delta Flight #552 leaving from Tegucigalpa, Honduras (TGU)
  - Trip participants may have ONE CARRY-ON size bag (Baggage must fit easily in the carry-on baggage area/approximately 22" x 14" x 9") and ONE PERSONAL ITEM (backpack, purse or computer bag).
  - For all liquids, gels, aerosols and pastes-limit each container to a maximum size of 3.4oz/100ml and **ALL must be in ONE quart size Ziploc bag**. Be sure to pack the quart bag in your backpack for easy access to remove at the airport security area. All food needs to be in a Ziploc Bag and in backpack for easy access during the airport security check.   - NO personal bags will be checked! All personal bags will be carried on the plane. (one carry on size and one personal)
  - Only luggage carrying ministry supplies for the trip will be checked.
- Things to be aware of...
  - Work is dirty and hot! We work rain or shine!
  - Travel is typically by a school bus w/ no air. The roads are bumpy and curvy. In Honduras, they have their own road rules...make a way!! If you get motion sickness, carry your medicine!
  - Be aware of surroundings...safety and culture
